- **Civils**

The fleet of 45 includes nine gully wagons and two vactor units provides reactive ability on a wide range of highways, commercial and private drainage works. MB is licenced to carry waste and has personnel approved to work on the highway:

Water jetting/Root cutting; CCTV surveys; Septic tank/treatment plant installation and servicing; Soakaway design/installation/maintenance; Drain installation, repairs and cleaning; Drain installation;

Culvert works; Confined spaces inspection; Gully cleaning; Combination High Pressure Water Jet Vacuum Unit.
